



## HOW TO GET HERE

### Road


*Address: Coombeshead Farm, Lewannick, Cornwall, PL15 7QQ\**

*\*if you are going to use a satnav please use 'Coombeshead Farm' rather than the postcode as this will be more accurate.*

**From the North and London:** when you pass signs to Launceston on the A30, continue on toward Bodmin for a little over four miles. Bear left onto the minor road signposted Lewannick and Plusha. At the T-junction turn left and follow the road up into the village of Lewannick and bear right toward Callington and North Hill. Follow the road around to the right passing the village church and continue for 200 yards taking the next left turning signposted Trelaske. Follow this lane out of the village and after a few hundred yards bear right signposted Congdon Shop and continue along this lane where the entrance drive to Coombeshead will be found on the left just after a left-hand bend.

**From Cornwall and the South West:** Leave the A30 signposted to Callington (B3257) by the petrol station. Take the first left signposted Lewannick. You will arrive in the village with the Archer Arms pub on your left. Follow the road straight ahead at the crossing, passing the village church (on your left) and continue for 200 yards taking the next left turning signposted Trelaske. Follow this lane out of the village and after a few hundred yards bear right signposted Congdon Shop and continue along this lane where the entrance drive to Coombeshead will be found on the left just after a left-hand bend.

**From South East (Plymouth / Callington/ Tavistock):** Continue on the B3257 through Bray's Shop, Coad's Green & Congdon's Shop. Take a right hand turn signposted to Lewannick. Keep going into the village. Turn right at the signpost to Trelask. Follow this lane out of the village and after a few hundred yards bear right signposted Congdon Shop and continue along this lane where the entrance drive to Coombeshead will be found on the left just after a left-hand bend.



## **Rail**

Regular intercity trains operate from Bodmin, Liskeard, Exeter, Tiverton Parkway and Plymouth. The closest train station to us is Gunnislake, which can be accessed easily from Cornwall. If you are coming from London or the North, we recommend exploring the following options:

- Train to Liskeard (roughly 3.5 – 4 hours from London, then a 25 minute / £30 taxi ride).
- Train from London Paddington to Exeter St David's (roughly 2.5 hours, then a 1 hour / £70-80 taxi ride).
- Train from London Waterloo to Exeter St David's (roughly 3.5 hours, then a 1 hour / £70-80 taxi ride).

We recommend you look at advance tickets and megatrain.com for reduced prices. You can also hire a car from Exeter and drive on down to us rather than taking a taxi, which will give you more flexibility to explore the local area.

## **Air**

Exeter and Newquay Airports provide flights to the Isles of Scilly, Channel Islands, London and several continental destinations. Both airports offer car hire facilities and can be more convenient than taking the train.

## **Ferry**

Cross channel ferry services operate from Plymouth to Brittany and northern Spain.

## **Taxis**

If you wish to use a taxi during your visit it is essential that you pre-book.
